
11 out of 11 students progressed from having below average knowledge and understanding to gaining good and excellent by the end of the 6 Week Inclusion Program.

Conclusion

100% of students increased in their confidence and boost in their self-esteem.

80% of students gained a more in-depth and increased understanding of all the topics we cover, in deepening their knowledge of well-being.

100% of students have learnt various techniques and tools, for example, mindfulness and positive mantras (I am statements), however, 80% of topics was learning new concepts and methods.



KPI

- Have reintegrated back into mainstream school and/or found an alternative route which is more appropriate for students to achieve and gain qualifications
- Attending school and lessons
- Attending lessons on time
- Reduce in detentions, sanctions, isolation and exclusions

Moving Forward: Inclusion Program for the borough

Due to the success of the program we will pilot in collaboration with The Warwick School as school lead and Surrey County Council to implement in all 12 partnering schools. 3 schools will host the program and all 12 schools will refer appropriate young people to the program. A prevention model to focus on key stag 3 year 7, 8 and 9.

We will collaborate with the Local Authority who will fund counsellors to support the students in lessons, transition and after the inclusion program has completed too.
